Resolution 8.1

The EUPOS Council

taking note of the election results for the Chair and the EUPOS Executive Board members

accepts

Branislav Droščák as EUPOS Chairman and Ambrus Kenyeres, Ingus Mitrofanovs, Szymon Wajda, Jaroslav Šimek and Jan Řezníček as EEB members for the period 2022 – 2026 and also

accepts

Ingus Mitrofanovs as EUPOS Vice-Chair for the period 2022 – 2026

Resolution 8.2

The EUPOS Council

recognizing

that Galileo has developed to a fully deployed global navigation satellite system and

noting

the efforts and investments of GNSS service providers and GNSS user community to make full use of Galileo as a part of a multi-GNSS system with a special importance for European countries and also

noting

the current efforts of European space organizations (EUSPA, GRC, ESA ...) towards a complex monitoring of Galileo performance over European continent, Galileo based space research and its applications and

regarding

the fact that in the EUPOS Technical Standards Galileo is considered to be a primary GNSS system

asks

the operators of national EUPOS segments to assess the possibilities how to employ the EUPOS potential in support of Galileo oriented efforts of European organizations by making available Galileo data

Resolution 8.3

considering

signal spoofing and jamming to be important disturbing sources with not negligible impact on the accuracy of GNSS positioning

recommends

the EUPOS members to share all available information and experience concerning spoofing and jamming through the EUPOS web page.
